We'll discuss the graphic novel *Smile* by Raina Telgemeier and make emoji pillows.

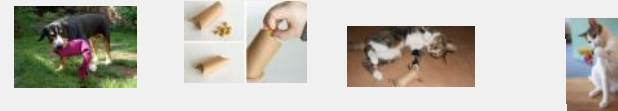

### Teen Summer Reading 2018 is Here!



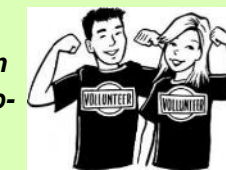
This Summer's program will run from Monday, June 18th through Friday, August 10th.
